UPDATE; SHELL AND BOWDITCH TENNIS COURTS

For the past several months, members of the Foster City Tennis Club Board have met regularly with Kevin Miller, Director of Parks and Recreation, to discuss tennis issues and facilities status. As many of you know, courts 1 and 2 (lower right in photo) at the Shell tennis courts have been scheduled for removal to provide space for the new permanent Teen Center and new permanent Skateboard Park. Kevin has indicated that the contract should be awarded in early March with construction on these new facilities beginning as soon as May. Kevin also stated that he will work with the contactors to try and keep the remaining courts (3-6) open during construction.

The Bowditch Middle School tennis courts are in need of resurfacing, as we all know. These courts, however, are the property of the Bowditch School, and they have jurisdiction over the use and facilities.

For the past several months, the FCTC Board has engaged in efforts to pull together all the interested groups to work with the school to find a way to pay for the resurfacing. The groups include the Middle School and District Office, the USA funding Grants, the FCTC, the adjacent condos homeowners association, Reynaldo Zalles of Zalles Sports, as well as several, behind the scenes, hard-working individuals. The Foster City Parks and Recreation Department and City Council are also aware of the issue. In the next couple of months, these groups plan to meet to discuss the process of resurfacing the courts, and determine a cost estimate and timeline.
